NPAFE proposes **Trésors de la Danse**, an exclusive Van Cleef & Arpels series of original contemporary ballet and modern dance presentations inspired by George Balanchine's "Jewels", and the recent Benjamin Millepied embodiment of Van Cleef & Arpels' appreciation of the art of dance. Centering on live performances in US cities having Van Cleef & Arpels retail outlets, **Trésors de la Danse** would also be captured in branded videos for Van Cleef & Arpels to use in media, print, and social media.

Brought together for the first time in an initiative like this, these world-class performers will extend the Van Cleef & Arpels marque to a geographically broad universe of audiences who show ever-deepening loyalty to marques supporting the performing arts.

Art Live and Imaged

Centered on newly choreographed works originated exclusively during this 2-3 year initiative, **Trésors de la Danse** would be created and presented by, among others, **Sidra Bell Dance New York**, **Kevin Jenkins**, **State Street Ballet**, **Lucy Bowen McCauley**, **and Paul Taylor**. These are among America's "treasure" star choreographers and dance companies, offering appealing promotional opportunities exclusively in the Van Cleef & Arpels name to the best of audiences.

Each creator-choreographer offers the special option of teaming with internationally known musicians who would compose original music for these Van Cleef & Arpels live works of art. These choreographers also have strong relationships with genius filmmakers practiced in the fine art of capturing the creative elements of live dance and music both during rehearsal and performance. One, Kevin Jenkins, is himself an acclaimed filmmaker-director as well as being considered one of America's best among the new generation of contemporary ballet choreographers.



Intentionally structured to reflect compellingly on the Van Cleef & Arpels marque as do its investments in producing the Balanchine and Millepied works, **Trésors de la Danse** anticipates empowering Van Cleef & Arpels to offer exclusive, invitation-only
